NEW YORK, Nov. 4.—The principal
returning officers of the state were
McKinley in New Jersey is increased to

to two o'clock are considered as indicating
that Bryan appears to be 266,387. Black,
republican candidate for governor, carries
the state by a plurality not much less.

The Tribune's latest edition says: Mo-
Kinley and Hobart swept the country
yesterday, winning at least 307 out of 447
electoral votes. There will be no less
than 250 republicans in the house of rep-
resentatives.

CHARLES CITY, Iowa, Nov. 4.—The
republicans have a two-thirds majority in
the senate.

Jersey added its voice to the north.
