SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Nov. 17.—By an opinion handed down by the United States circuit court of appeals yesterday the British steamer Corwin, with 6,100 seal skins, seized by the revenue steamer Corwin, in June, 1892, and ordered forfeited to the government by the district court of Alaska, was released. The decision of the Alaska court was reversed on every point and the libel order dismissed.
