Alex. McLaren, of Manchester, in lecture lately said that Spurgeon is a man of great spiritual influence, and is the greatest man in the pulpit to-day. Beecher is the philosopher of the pulpit. Mr. Spurgeon's method of conducting services is this:-"He takes his text: They sing as it were s new song; and he takes up the songs they have just sung and tells them that the songs now are not enitable for heaven. He reads :-Jesus, lover of my soul, Let me to thy bosom fly.

This song will not do. There will be no nearer waters. There will be no howling tempest, nor storm, nor darkness. We will sing a new song,' and then he apostrophizes:- 'Tell me, Jacob, wilt thou sing louder than I; and thou, Deborah, wilt thou sing loader than I; and thou, Miriam, wi't thou strike thy timbrel louder than I will sing! I tell ye nay, angels and archangels, cherubim and seraphim, and prophets, not one of you shall sing as loud as 1, not one of you shall sing as loud as 1, for I sing of a Christ ye never knew, of a Christ ye never knew, of a glory ye never knew." And as he clies 'Glory be to God for the new song, 'the whole audience cry 'amen, 'The lecturer then gave in the g amen, amen." 


