

Township Council of Pittsburg

Dec 21st.—The Council met at 1:50 p.m. All members present. Communications were read from Jno. Agnew, P. S. Inspector, relating to the decision of the County Committee in the school dispute case.

On the petition of the Trustees of S.S. No. 9, referred from a former meeting, was moved by Mr. Anglin, seconded by Mr. Graves, that the Trustees furnish satisfactory evidence in a surveyor's certificate as to the distance the parties complained of reside from the proposed school to which they have attached themselves.

On application of W. Woods for aid to repair road between the 3rd and 4th concessions. Moved by Mr. Anglin, seconded by Mr. Graves, that \$7 be granted, and that P. Blake, road engineer, superintend the repairs.—Carried.

The following bills were passed: Messrs. Bowen & Co., \$40, for an iron safe; R. O'Connell, \$2, bridge; J. McLean, \$4, repairs done to bridge in 4th con.; Wm. Elder, \$8.81, for broken stone; Department of Militia and Defence, \$6, repairs to mangle and road in 8th con.; and \$2.50 for ditching done on Phillips road; R. Gough, \$9.50, and Jas. Waller, \$6, on account of broken stone.

Moved by Mr. Anglin, seconded by Mr. Martin, that those taxpayers in the township, who are members of the active militia, and who have horses enrolled in the volunteer, artillery or cavalry, be exempted from municipal assessment on said horses, and that the Collector proceed to assess the same on receipt of a certificate from the commanding officers, and from the assessors, as to the value placed on said horses, at the time of assessment.—Carried.
