It probably resulted from the fact that large droves of hogs were sent over to the island to feed, after the establishment of Fort Frontegac. In Bouchesti's history, dated 1815, "Isle aux Cochons' is no longer mentioned, but the island was represented by the name "Garden Island." A large amount correspondence by Dr. Walkem regarding the name of the island, was fruitless. D. W. Smith's provincial geography, published between 1796 and 1800, a reference is made to "Isle aux Cochons" and it is also stated that the name of "Tele aux Cochons" has been changed to "Howe Island" by


