SPANISH WERE UNREADY TO MEET DEWEY'S ATTACK ON MANILLA.

Spain in England For Dewey's Skill and Daring and Credit to Admiral Montojo - Will Try Conclusions in the Atlantic.

LONDON, May 3.—It appears that Admiral Montojo was taken altogether by surprise, and that the Spanish authorities generally were in a state of utter unpreparedness.

The moral influence of the first great victory is incalculable and though it is practically certain that Spain will yield to the United States, there were no signs in Cuban waters would produce signs of revolution in Spain.

Secures A Prize. KEY WEST, May 3.—The United States gunboat Castine, commander R. N. Barry, brought in this morning a small prize, the two-masted fishing schooner, Antonio y Pico, having on board a cargo of fish.

Did Not Reach Manila. LONDON, May 3.—A special despatch from Madrid says the Spanish colonial office had advised of the beginning of the bombardment of Manila before cable was cut which said: "Thus far the American shells have not reached the town proper, which is strongly protected. Only the outlying native quarters have suffered."

Marital Law Has Been proclaimed at Madrid: It is due to the attitude of certain political parties. News from Hong Kong shows that the cable was cut fifty miles from Manila. A week or fortnight may elapse before it can be repaired.

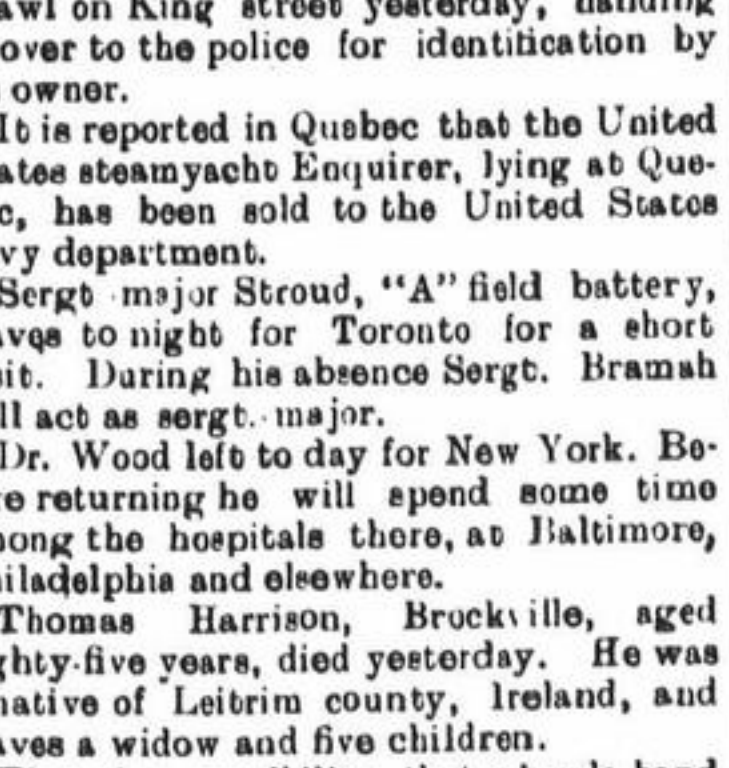

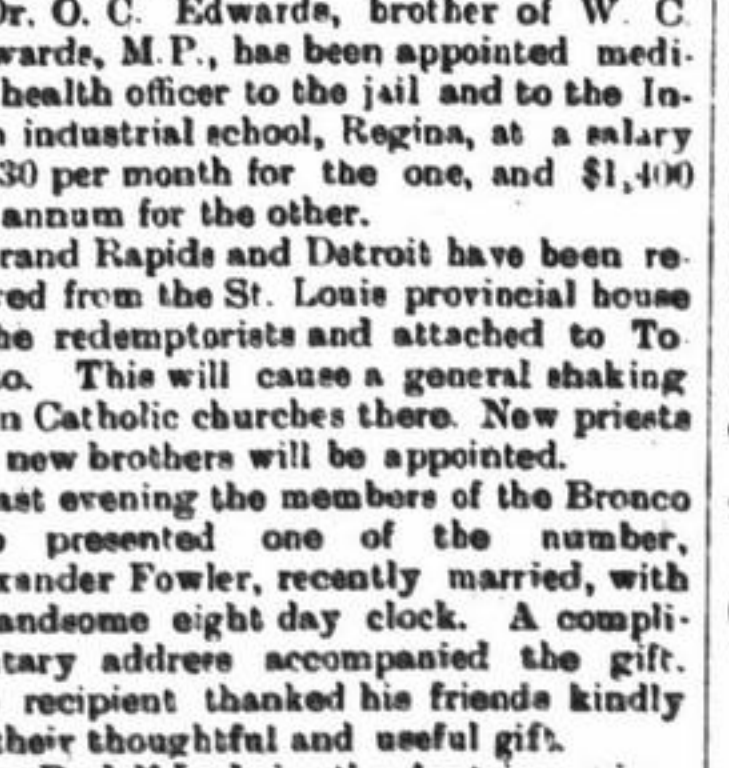
