THE MIKADO'S COUSIN HERE.

Prince Komatsu is on His Way Home to Help Fight the Chinese.



Prince Komatsu, first cousin of the Mikado of Japan, is now traveling incognito in this country, which he has known since he was a boy.

The prince is a slender, athletic looking Japanese of 27 years. He weighs 150 pounds, wears the very best clothes of European style that can be obtained for coin of the realm in Paris and London. His dress is of the latest fashion, and he has a plain gold ring. He has bright, black, beautiful eyes, a small but well trained black mustache and a black hair that is characteristic of Japanese, whether royal blood courses in their veins or not.

He speaks English and French, and is a thoroughgoing European. He is a thoroughly up to date man of the most progressive royal house. Japan has never been so fortunate enough to possess him.

The prince is married, but not very much married, for he has but one wife, like other progressive princes. He belongs to one of the four royal families in Japan—the Komatsu, Arisugawa, Fushimi and Kanin. If the emperor should die without a male representative of one of these families would be chosen to succeed him.

The suit of the prince is not large, consisting of a secretary, Michinori S. Nagasaki, and two male servants. Secretary Nagasaki has also a very pretty girl as Pook Bah of "Mikado" fame. He received his English education at the University of Michigan, about 15 or 16 years ago and is not only a master of English, but of politeness as well.
