HAMILTON WILL PAY A DEBT. A Claim From Quebec For Debentures

Issued In 1862, HAMILTON, April 13 .- Some forty years ago Hamilton took stock in small railway enterprises, and issued debentures. \$90,000, to pay for the stock. The debentures came into the possession of the government of old Canada and \$80,000 were redeemed. The remaining \$10,000 appeared too have got lost in the shuffle or overlooked; at any rate they fell into possession of the Quebec government. The amount due the Quebec government on' account of principal and interest is \$18,028.
