Salisbury's Plan of Campaign Against Home Rule in the Upper House. A LARGE ADVERSE MAJORITY. Conservative Tories Regarded With Disfavor—The Rejection of Home Rule May Precipitate the Conflict Between the Lords and Commons.

London, Sept. 5.—The Marquis of Salisbury plans to make the decisive division on the Home Rule Bill in the House of Lords the occasion of a great Tory rally. Not content with the normal majority of the Lords against the Government, he is resolved that every Tory peer should be reached by the whip shall be present to record his opposition to the Gladstonian policy. At his instance the Tory whips have sent exceptionally urgent notices to all members of their party in the Upper House.

More Deaths in England. London, Sept. 5.—Another patient—the daughter of the previous victim—died of cholera in Hull yesterday. It is reported there were two deaths from cholera in Grimsby yesterday.

Cholera Carried by Water. London, Sept. 5.—A four-year-old boy was rescued in an unconscious condition from the water in the Northfarms in this city on August 24, and has been attacked with cholera. He is now in the Moabit hospital. This is the first case of cholera being brought into the city since the epidemic broke out in Hull and Grimsby.

Seven Deaths in Hull and Grimsby. London, Sept. 5.—On fresh case of cholera was found in Hull yesterday. Sir Walter Foster, Parliamentary Secretary of the Local Government Board, is in the House of Commons, said that seven deaths had occurred in Hull and Grimsby. He added that every precaution was being taken against the epidemic.

Regarded With Disfavor. London, Sept. 5.—Not all Unionists look with favor on the Salisbury plan of rallying the Conservative majority of the Lords to vote against the bill. Such course, they feel, must direct general attention to the broadening chasm between the Lords and the Commons, and tend to precipitate the fight of the British democracy against the Upper House.

United States National Banks to Be Reorganized as State Institutions. New York, Sept. 5.—A Washington special to the Whig says: It has been ascertained that the United States National Banks and the members of the House Committee on Banking and Currency, Messrs. McMillan and Warner, of New York, President Chase, and the organization of the national banks as institutions, and for the repeal of the 10 per cent. tax on national bank notes.
