ADMISSIONS ANCHORED.

French Newspapers Endeavor to Rouse Anti-British Sentiment. ENGLAND'S HAND IN MOROCCO. Rabid Paris Journals Say She is Working to Establish a French Colony Over That Country. French Capital Preparing to Receive Russia's Fleet.

PARIS, Oct. 12.—The reception of the Russian fleet at Toulon is but a day off, and the Russian fever grows hourly in intensity. The newspapers now give daily long lists of Russian officials and dignitaries who have come to Paris to witness the fleet.

Russian decorations are seen everywhere in such variety and beauty as would not be possible in any other continental capital. Dealers and manufacturers have been put to their wits' end to produce novelties which will appeal to the popular fancy. The shops have in their windows English portraits of the Czar and the Admiral Avrasov, who commands the visiting squadron. Within are shown toys and bric-a-brac adorned with the Russian flag and the colors of the Russian army.

They have found in the attacks of the Moors on the Spaniards at Melilla only another evidence of English perfidy.
