WHY ACTION WAS TAKEN.

IT WAS FOR DISREPAIR DURING HORSE CAR DAYS.

The City Council has a Notice Calling for the Payment of Three Hundred Dollars—The Company Replied With Another Notice For Fifteen Hundred Dollars.

Citizens were surprised when read in the papers, last evening, that the Kingston, Portsmouth and Cataract electric railway company had, through Walker & Walker, solicitors, asked for \$1,500 as compensation for violation of the contract to keep the road and streets over which the rails for the horse railway were laid in repair.

A reporter sought out why had caused the company to demand compensation, and it was this:

Some years ago the city entered into an agreement, not a very wise one, to keep the street railway track in repair, if the company would pay \$150 yearly. As far as the city is concerned this contract was never carried out. It is true attempts were made to keep the streets in repair, but the work was not thoroughly carried out. This was apparent without being brought to the attention of the public. Complainants were numerous that the street railway was in a dangerous condition. In some places the road was high and in others low, and the cars were continually running up and down in consequence of the unevenness of the streets. Mr. Folger, superintendent, said that on public days when the company expected to make considerable money, it was handicapped by bad streets and an efficient service could not be given. On the day of the opening of the athletic grounds the company lost \$200 through a car running off the track, because the street was not level.

The company might not have made the claim of \$1,500 against the city had it not been for the fact that the city had agreed to pay the street railway in repair when the work was not done.

Acting Mayor McKelvey says the finance committee should hold a meeting immediately to deal with the claim. There is one thing certain it was impossible to keep the street railway track in repair while two horses drew each car. But if the city and company are both to blame in the matter, one for neglecting to pay for the work done and the other for not doing so, a settlement should be effected in some way. It would not be well to go to law.

SENATOR SULLIVAN SPEAKS. The Teaching Staff of the Collegiate Institute Must Be Sustained.

This morning Dr. Sullivan, member of the Kingston collegiate institute board, was spoken to in respect to the reported resignation in relation to the discipline of the institute. He said that if Mr. Ellis, the principal, considered that to punish pupils for neglecting to keep their promise by keeping them in after school hours, was an effective way to bring about desired discipline, neither he (the speaker) nor anyone else had a right to interfere with him. It is reported that sixty pupils who had offended were guilty of having promised the principal they would come to school at a certain hour and failed to keep their word. If the punishment did not more good than to impress upon the pupils the importance of keeping their word, it would be of inestimable value. The people of this city are very lax in this respect. It is very common for people to promise to do things without any intention of doing them. If any sympathy is created for the pupils in the case, it will be false and harmful to the future discipline of the institute. The board, having chosen a teaching staff in which they have perfect confidence, should not be disturbed by the resignation of Mr. Ellis. A resolution should be passed agreeing with Mr. Ellis' mode of discipline. The children attending the schools are pampered to such an extent at home by parents, who try to believe exaggerated stories of their ill-treatment by teachers, whose sole object it is to bring them properly to school. They are men and women others with honor. When the doctor went to school he and his companions had a "bark" and if they were given "the bark" was sometimes taken off with a birch rod. This rigid discipline did not do the boys harm. In fact they grew up to years of manhood and they were glad to remember their teacher had not spared the rod on them.

MARINE INTELLIGENCE. Paragraphs Picked Up About the Wharves and Elsewhere.

The str. Persia had a big load of freight down this morning. The ship Valerius cleared for Cape Vincent with 2,100 cedar ties to-day. Arrivals—Prop. Argonaut, Chicago, 4,000 bushels corn; str. Persia, St. Catharines.
