THE BRITISH ELECTIONS.

GLADSTONE'S MAJORITY WILL BE EXACTLY 42.

Thomas Boston Keir in County Kerry.

London, July 20.—Thomas Keir, M.P., has been elected to the House of Commons for the North division of County Kerry by 202 majority. His opponent was Mr. Parnell, who received only 771 votes.

There have now been elected 609 members of the House of Commons out of the 700 constituting that body. With the polling in the Orkney Islands, which takes place next week, the contests will be over.

The parties now stand: Conservatives 314, Opposition 353.

The remaining district is certain to return a supporter of Gladstone, so the Conservatives' majority in the House will be 42.
