





A THRILLING EXPERIENCE IN AN ARI-ZONA CANON.

Flooing From the Torrent-It was a Ride for Life-Saved by an Overhanging Bush -The Clouds Rolled by and Nature Smiled Serenely Again,

"Speaking of cloudbursts," said Col unknown country at that time, and filled

"We had started out early one morning came up clear and hot, and Brown remarked to me as we toiled up the narrow canon that we were sure of a fine day at any rate. 


