



beer shops of 1,060, the beer, coffee and tea houses of 226, the gin shops of 232, and the retail traders of 1,004. On the other hand the coffee, tes and chocolate rooms have decreased by 23; the confectioners by 7, and the sodawater booths by 5. According to the census of De-cember, 1890, the population was 1,576,-794 souls, and there was a beer or wine shop for every 185 persons. In the year 1883 the proportion was the same, but in the year 1881 it was one for every 170 persons. The report especially discusses the so-called Vienna cafes and the beer and trine shops employing waitresses, which have increased.
