The barometer published in 1836 an opera, "The Bridgroom".

The early agricultural society had only thirty members in 1837.

Barth had in 1836 an "annual school," kept by Mrs. Jones, postmaster.

The building of Fort Henry was commenced in 1812 and completed in 1819.

Four men were drawn off a Colborne Bay fishing boat near St. John's, in 1835.

In 1834 Kingston had five wharves, Cartwright's, McInnis', McDonnell's, Kirby's and Seabell's.

In 1836 Kingston founded a Galtic society to promote the cause. John A. McDonald was secretary.

His condensed soldiers escaped from Kingston in April, 1837. The jailer had to flee in haste.

The Park of St. North America and Kingston field battery, (Capt. Jackson), were established in 1837.

Kingston street was formerly Stone street, named so because of the stone quarries.

During the great financial panic of 1837, the Commercial bank of Kingston was the only one to remain open.

Blair's brewery, formerly Dalrymple's, is the only one of its kind in Kingston.

If his brewing were not so good he could not have lived over seventy years.
