THE FARMERS' MUST ACT.

In a letter to the *Napasee Express* Allen Pringle, a Lenox farmer, tells his brother farmers that it is the time to talk about scientific and economical agriculture at their institute meetings. "I care not," he says, "how well a farmer may till his soil and manage his business, or how industrious or saving he may be, if the product of his toil and of his thift is largely wrested from him according to law." Mr. Pringle estimates that the average farmer pays at least a dollar or more every year in direct or indirect tax and is disposed to think that the amount is nearly twice that. His advice is that farmers should "east and drink" party divisions and work together to lift the feet of their legislators from their necks. The farmers in the States have adopted that plan with very considerable success.

COLONIAL CONFERENCE.

The Canadian *Advertiser* reports that Sir Gordon Spragg, a leading statesman of South Africa, made an important speech at the meeting of the city of London branch of the imperial federation league recently. He recommended that the members of the federation league should press her majesty's government to address the governments of the various colonies and dependencies and invite a conference on the practicability of forming a commercial union between the different colonies and dependencies of the empire. "It is not," said he, "in accord with the English genius to lay down grand and comprehensive schemes. Every colony is a unit in the English polity has been obtained on the principle of proceeding step by step.
