LONDON, Feb. 14.—The real name of the banker known as Victor Maes, whose disappearance was announced yesterday, is Bernoulli. Among his clients were about 600 priests. The Pope recently went to Bernoulli's papal benediction and a photograph of him bearing his signature was taken. This had the effect of increasing the banker's credit among the clergy. The money deposited with Bernoulli amounted to 1,000,000 francs monthly. As a last resort he went to Monte Carlo.
