In September the lambs were weened and placed on dry feed, and satisfactory price at weaning time when just changing from green to dry feed. As green clover will easily yield 24,000 lbs to the acre and green fodder 36,000 lbs, these feeds would bring \$24 and \$36 per acre, which are good
