Taught by an Insect. Mark Gambard Brunel, the famous engifame of your preparation is spreading abroad | neer, claimed that he was indebted to an nsect for a great and useful invention The story, as told in Golden Days, is as fol

Brunel was one day in a shipyard watching the movements of an insect known as the teredo navalis-in English, the naval wood worm-when a brilliant thought suddenly occurred to him. He saw that this creature bored its way into a piece of wood upon which it was operating by means of a very extraordinary mechanical apparatus Looking at the animal attentively through a microscope, he found that it was covered in front with a pair of valvular shells that, with its foot as a purchase, it communicated a rotary motion and a forward mpulse to the valves, which, acting upon the wood like a gimlet, penetrated its substance, and that, as the particles of wood were loosened, they passed through a fissure in the foot, and thence through the body of the borer to its mouth, where they




