THE SUCTION PIPE.

It seems passing strange that Mr.
Roussens should persist in laying the suc-
tion pipe when it has failed so signally to
stand the test required of it by specifica-
tions. It has not been a most point be-
tween the contractor and the aldermen as
to what the pressure will be on the pipe
when laid and performing the services for
what it has been designed, but what the
real pressure it was expected to resist
before it was laid for use at all. It leaked
badly in the tests and the committee ex-
pressed its disapproval, and yet Mr. Rou-
ssens proceeded to put the pipe down, finish
the contract in his own way, and force it upon the city. We do no presume to know
as much about the law of the land as Mr. Agnew, our city solicitor, and
we know enough to warrant the conclusion
that Mr. Roussens is proceeding illegally and irregularly. Granted
that he is in hard luck, that he tendered no
low, under the estimate of what the en-
gine said the work would cost, that he has
been delayed in getting the iron, and that
even now the water is turbulent and de-
structive in its action and seriously against
him—granted that he is a loser in the under-
taking and to be pitied for his losses—and
the situation remains the same. His work
has not passed inspection, but is not, in the
opinion of some experts, met requirements,
and will not be accepted. Then why per-
sist in the folly of fighting the corporation?
As an old contractor Mr. Roussens may
think that in the end there will be a com-
promise, that the members of the council
will not remain hard-headed until the end
of the piece. The aldermen certainly exhib-
it no signs of weakening, and it would be
astonishing if they did and yet presumed to act
as custodians of the public interest.
