

PHYSIOLOGY AND HYGIENE.

Nitro-Glycerine as a Medicine-Perils and

Discomforts of the Season. Dr. Kloman, of Bultimore, tells in The Maryland Medical Journal of a case of asthma, with accompanying weak heart, in which he used a 1 per cent, solution of nitroglycerine with good result. The patient was a man of 82 years, the dose given was three drops and had the effect of averting impending attacks of asthma. On one occasion the old man spent the afternoon and evening away from home, and when he returned was thoroughly chilled, feeling also the commencing shortness of breath. His wife administered to him three drops of the solution of nitro-glycerine. The effect was almost instantaneous. He soon became warm, and the threatening asthmatic attack was prevented.

Reasoning from its physiological effects upon the capillaries-admitting more blood to the surfaces-Dr. Kloman suggests that nitro-glycerine might be highly beneficial in cases of threatened gangrene of the extremities., Tableids of nitro-glycerine have lately superseded the solution for both hypodermic and internal administration.

Excellent Effects from Hot Water. A strip of flannel or a napkin dipped in hot water and wrung out and then applied a larger and thicker towel, will usually bring relief in ten minutes. > For the Prevention of Cold Feet. To people who suffer from cold feet, and especially those who from the nature of their work are obliged to remain out of doors in severe weather, standing or sitting most of the time in one position, as, for example, teamsters, hackmen, car drivers and conductors, the following rule, from what is known as the "Swedish Movement System," is commended: Stand erect, and very gradually lift yourself upon the tips of the toes, so as to put all the tendons of the feet at full strain. This should not be done spasmodically, but slowly and gradual, the slower the better, and remain standing in that position as long


