

Belleville, April 19. - A note made by Jacob Ira Cook of Marmora for \$2000 and endorsed by three good farmers was sent to the Bank of Montreal here to be discounted on behalf of the Tweed Bank. Mr. Richardson, manager of the Bank of Montreal, was suspicious and refused to discount the note. An enquiry having been instituted it was found that the endorsations were forgeries. It is said that the Traders' Bank, Madoc, has a similar note for \$2000 and O'Flynn's Bank, Madoc, another for \$500. Cook is the manager and proprietor of a cheese factory and has a good farm in Marmora. His credit was in every way good. Yesterday he disappeared. Every effort will be made to have him arrested.


