The display eclipses that of any previous show in recent years

the patronage of the people now is only lacking

In the exhibits of cattle, horses and live stock generally

the farmers of Frontenac and vicinity show what they can do

and it is greatly to their credit

WALK THROUGH THE PALACE

The crystal palace contains a great variety of goods

the quantity being greater than has been shown before

Just within one of the entrances is the display of stoves

of hard wood, coal and coal oil

resplendent with nickel plated ornaments

The exhibitors are R. M. Horsey, T. Lemmon and Chown & Cunningham

These also show grates, shovels, tongs, screens and other useful articles in the iron monger's line

Kingston goods being pre eminent

The qualities are the same as those which took prizes at the Dominion and Provincial exhibitions

James Richmond & Co. have a monument constructed of Brussels carpets, wool and reversible mats and rugs

wood furnishings, cornice poles and stair rods

The pyramid is exceedingly attractive

Close at hand is a case of the choicest millinery of this popular house

The Singer, Wheeler & Wilson, and Williams' sewing machines make music for the masses

as they are constantly operated

Some of these machines are highly ornamental

The pink background particularly sets off the exhibit
