A serious conflagration occurred on Monday evening, about 10:15 p.m. Mr. Wallace, night foreman of the news department of the Herald, went down stairs to make enquiries concerning some copy, and on returning he noticed a strong smell of burning, and on opening the door he found the press-room met by a terrific rush of smoke. The editorial, business, and mechanical staffs were working as usual in their respective departments. These were at once notified, and the building was evacuated, and the necessary alarm, and the reels were somewhat late in consequence. Meanwhile the flames, assisted by a wind running through the centre of the building, sprang from floor to floor with terrible rapidity, and breaking through the skylight, gave many present an idea that the fire had originated on the upper flat. The basement was actually the scene of the fire. In the sudden alarm it was for a time forgotten that the wife and daughter of Mr. Gunn, caretaker of the building, were asleep in their rooms on the upper flat. Mr. Gunn, the editor's staff, Mr. Williams, proof reader, and Mr. Quinn, printer, together rushed to their rescue. The smoke was suffocating. Mr. Gunn, after breaking into the room, seized Miss Gunn and carried her down stairs, and Mr. Quinn, after finding her mother, Mr. Gunn was found lying on the floor in an unconscious condition. Mrs. Gunn was attempting to save an insurance policy, when overcome by the smoke, she fell, and her husband, who was absent at the time, and his feelings upon arriving and finding the place in flames can be better imagined and described.
