CTARTLING DISCOVERY LOST MANHOOD RESTORED.

PRINCIPAL IRONCLADS. Mistery of the Men-et-War Doing Ser Vice at Alexandrin - Eguipped for

Very Bendly Service. The Inflexible, when she was launch ed in 1876, was regarded as the most formidable engine of naval warfare in the world, though she cannot now be compared with the great Italian ironclads. She is a turn-screw turret ship 320 feet long between perpendiculars. and 75 feet in breadth at the wide t part, being literally a rectangular armoured castle. All the vulnerable parts of the ship are enclosed in the central citadel ; the remaining sections are simply designed to float it. This "box," 110 feet by 75, is armoured feet 9 inches above the water-line; and 9 leet 7 inches below it. The plating varies in thickness, but at the most vital point consists of 24 inches of solid iron in two coats, each strengthened by garders, backed by teak paking 17 inches thick, moking a wall 41 inches thick. The turre s are placed on either side of the ship en echelon within the citadel walls, tue fore-turret on the port side so that all four guns can be discharged simultaneously in the same direction The guns can also be depressed so as to fire down on the deck of an enemy alongside. The turrets, of 28 feet in ternal diameter, are formed of a single thickness of armour, 18 inches thick backed with as much wood and an in per from skin. The Inflexible has cre w of about 350 men, but two men can work each of the guns. She has a speed of 14 knots, but is not a very handy vessel in a seaway. Her first cost was about \$3,000,000. The Inflexible's 81 ton guns are designed to throw a projectile weighing 1,700 pounds, with a 350 pound charge of powder, and the vessel carries 120 rounds per gun. The calibre is 16 inches. In the trials at Shoebm ypess, with a full charge of 445 pounds, and a 1,760 pound projectile, one of these guns gave a velocity at the muzzle of 1,657 feet per second, showing

of a ship with 32 inches of armour. Its range is about ten miles. The Superb, a vessel of the second class, mounting 16 guns, four being 25 ton, was one of the two ironclads built for the Turkish Government during the Russo Turkish war, and detained by England to avoid international compli cations. She was sold in England it 1878 for \$2.265.000. Her 25 ton guns throw a 600 pound shot with a powder charge of 85 pounds, and have a pene tration into armour of nearly 12 inches. The Monarch, 7 guns, Sultan, and other vessels are rigged ships for cruising, the first named being the only rig ged turret ship of the iron clad navy The Sultan, 12 guns, long commanded by the Duke of Edinburgh, was extensively repaired three years ago, and is laborately armed with torpedoes, Gatlings, and Nordenfeldts to repel board ers. The Alexandra, 12 guns, is a stronger vessel than the others of her lass, and is of an improved construction. The Temeraire, 8 gnus, embodies in her construction both the turret and the broadside principle, and is especially note worthy for the fact that in her, for the first time in the history of iron clads, was an equilibrium introduced between weight and steam power.


