





Since then the British military ystem has been entirely rovolutionized. At one time " the fool of the family entered the army, but this is no longer. the education of the British officer, and sailor has been made so thorough that the fools are not "in it. With officers whose "heads work well, to use an American phrase, controlling 40.000 picked men, there is little chance for even a hundred thousand Egyptians and Bedouins. Should the British forces and Arabi meet at Cairo the engagement will be short and decisive. Great things are expected from the Commander in Chief, Sir Garnet Wolse. ley, from Major General Sir E. B. Hamley, commanding the second division, from Major General G. Graham, commanding the 2nd Brigade; from Major General Sir E. Wood, commanding the 4th Brigade; and Colonel Sir W. Owen Lanyon. Lieut.-General Bir John Adve who has been appointed Chief of the Staff and second in command of the army in Egypt, is considered too old to form a prominent figure in the war. Sir Garnet Wolsely is a man of great ambition, activity and nerve, not a great man but a very clever soldier. He saw service in the Burmese War of 1852.3,

twice wounded in the Crimea, and wounded again during the Chinese War. 

GROWTH OF TIMBER.

Division of the Department of Agriculture, who wrote on the duties of the Government on the subject. He oblands belong to the Provincial Governments, excepting in Manitoba and the North-Western Territories, in which they are owned by the Dominion Goverument. The plan of management differs somewhat in its details, but in the main is this: The forest is leased, generally at a certain ground rent per square mile, and tor short periods, and a certain rate of tax is collected upon the timber that is taken out. If two lumbermen want the same tract it is put up at auction, and the man who pays the most for the privilege, in addition to the ground rent and the rate tax. obtains it; but generally the man who has made improvements, and has complied with the terms of his lease, is allowed to renew it from year to year until the timber is allowed removed. The soil itself is retained by the Govern. ment, and after a lapse of time it may again come iuto market for the sale of




