

Major Madge, Secretary of the Quebec Rife Association, proceeded to his tent and procured a towel, and was returning to give it to Dewfall when he was stopped by Gen. Luard, who was eagerly observing the whole proceedings, hav-

ing previously missed the towel from he man's kit. General Luard asked Mudge what he was doing with the owel and requested him to state ho he was. Here Major Scott stepped up and said that having sent Mudge for the towel he was responsible. 
