



If General Luard were to preface every command with a "Pinatoric" "if you please, would not be democratic enough for some of our esteemed contemporaries Yet they would not compare the strict ness of discipline in vogue here with the discipline exacted in the regu lar force, and Von Moltke regards even these as little better than an armed mob. The weak point about most volunteer organizations is to be annul among the officers, who, in proportion to what is expected of them, are generally less efficient than the rank and file. We do not say this is especial ly the case with the Canadian volum teer-, but it is the general rule. But is not the rule for officers to set the example of insubordination, and if it be comes the rule in any force, that force will speedily become the laughing stock of all soldiers. Any commanding officer who undertakes to improve the militia will have a hard task, so long as raw rerusts are encouraged to snub veterans who are their superior officers. We do not believe, and should be sorry t hink that the majority of our voluncers are merely playing at soldiers in lit is not lair to them for the press to convey such an impression abroad. that they themselves enjoy.




