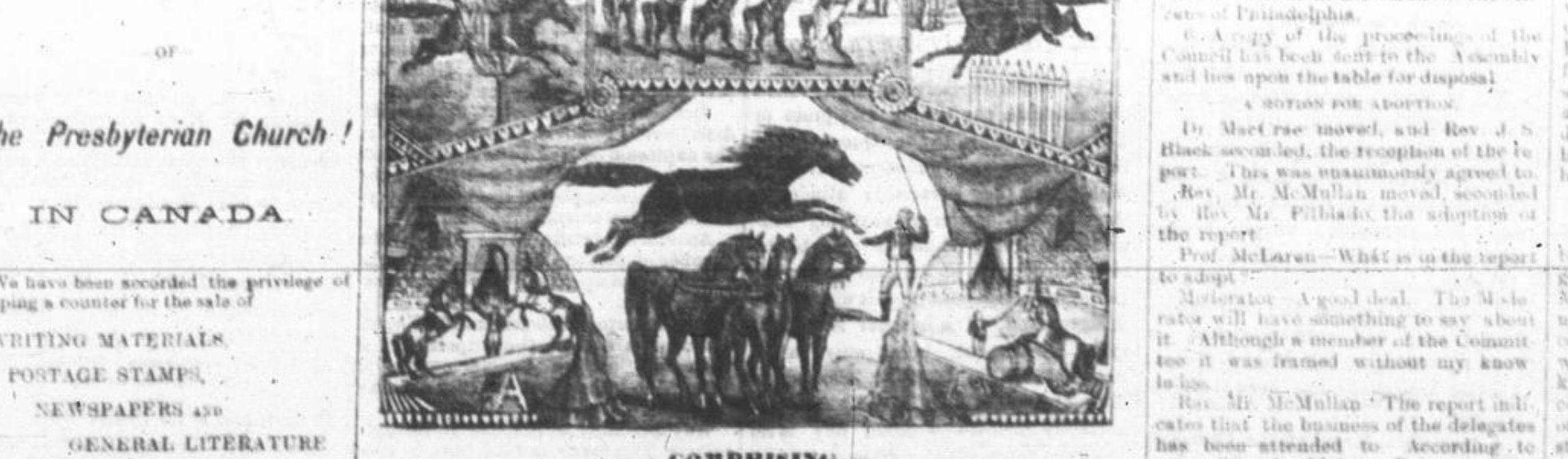

## GENERAL ASSEMBLY

An Exciting Debate Avoided - Dr. McKee  
Falls Plainly to the Church - Inter-  
esting Work in Figures.

At the afternoon Session yesterday  
after some preliminary reports, Rev. Dr. Mc-  
Kee introduced the report of the dele-  
gates to the Presbytery of the  
Church in Canada at the Council  
held last September in Philadelphia.
