MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT. PREPARING FOR THE ENSUING ELECTIONS—TWO HOLIDAYS FULLY DECLARED. High School Trustees—A Statement Submitted—Assessment of Yearly Property, Expenses and City Treasurer's Electoral Appointment.
