Our Canadian neighbors are in a very high and lefty mood just now: Retalia-tion is the burden of their song. In this spirit they have put the present Conservative Ministry in power, and Dr. Tupper and his colleagues are expected, at the coming session of Parliament, to tinker the tariff in the most rigorously retelistory fashion. Now, it may well be said to our cousins of the Dominion that this is a game at which two can play. If they are only trying to bluff this retaliatory talk has gone far enough. If they mean business, Uncle Sam will not shrink from the contest which their new retaliatory policy forces upon him. And there are abundant means at his disposal to help him to cut a very respectable figure in the fight. For instance, take the article of sugar, on which we at present impose a duty that yields up about \$37,000,000 per annum. Most of the sugar that reaches this port comes in Provincial bottoms. But suppose we should warm up to this work of retalistion and raise that \$37,000,000 on some other articles that we could easily suggest, and take the duty off sugar, providing always, that in order to exempt it must be brought in American bottoms. That would encourage the revival of American shipping, stimulate the Boston earrying trade to and from the West Indies, and at the same time give our friends across the toarder a taste of their own medicine. Retaliation is not half so good a word as Reciprocity for Canada, if she could only think so, and she probably will just directly. She cannot afford to quarrel with the Republic, either commercially or in any other way. If she must retaliste le' her take one of


