The nev circumstance of any importance was the State ball. Not a single individual known as a representative of any of the newspapers of the country received an invitation. The reporters or correspond ents did not feel sufficiently slighted even then to refer to the matter. But circumstances have come to light since from which it would seem that the omission was international.


