

ANTI-CHINESE BILL.
In the veto to the Anti-Chinese Bill, the Barington Treaty with the Chinese is reviewed at length, under which the Chinese are granted the privilege of American citizenship, and the President expresses his belief that this privilege, secured by treaty, cannot be suddenly withdrawn without leaving the United States open to the entire people of the United States, and imperilling the comfort and perhaps the lives of missionaries and people of the States living in China.

When the President's veto was read in the House the question was put, "Shall the Bill pass over the objection of the President?" The vote resulted 109 to 90. There being two-thirds in the affirmative the Bill was rejected. Most of the negative votes came from the Republican side, but a considerable number came also from Democratic side.
