



As the British Government had declared that the quarrel was not one with the people of Afghanistan, but with Shere Ali, his flight from his dominions appeared to have ended the campaign by removing the cause. As sufficient territory had been already conquered to constitute a scientific frontier, the last great object of the campaign, further warring seemed cruel and unecessary, especially as the country was in a state of internecine warfare. All that remained was to await the appointment of a ruler by the Afghans themselves, and treat with him for the cression of the territory already occupied, and confirm him on the throne. Shere Ali's death paved the way, and of the three or four candidates to the throne, Yakoob Khan seems to have been chosen, and communications have already passed between him and the British Government through their political agent, Major Cavagnari. Of the matter of the communication the Government alone is aware, but we are inform ed that the manner of it was anything but satisfactory, even defiant in tone. Coupled with this is the news that Gener al Browne's division is concentrating at Jetlelabad, which means probably a march through the fatal Khoord Cabul Pass to the capital itself.
