EX-MAYOR BAUDRY. CONTINUATION OF THE PLAINTIFF'S ANSWER TO THE PLEA.

(H. Jones.) Mr. Baudry's answer to the plea, filed by Mr. Roy, City Attorney, in continuation of that which was published yesterday, says: That the plaintiff alleged in said plea of certain Legislative grants of incorporation to the members of Orange Association was not, as it is averred, based upon apprehensions of illegal or unlawful conduct from such associations, to which the right to perform duties which are subjects being bound either by natural born duty or by naturalization to uphold Her Majesty's crown and supremacy, no claim of subjects were entitled to claim the right to perform duties which the common law imposed upon every class or person in the community.
