Among the many important and value able inventions in firearms, of which the present century has been prolific, there is mone that equals the Gatling gan in originality of design, rapidity of fire, and effectiveness. The severest tests and trials; and its practical use in warfare, have indisputably established its high reputation as a most formidable death dealing wespon. The main features of the gun may be summed up as follows ; It has usually five or ten barrels, each barrel having its corresponding lock. The barrels and locks revolve together; but in addition to this action, the locks have a forward and backward motion of their own. The forward motion places the cartridges in the chambers of the barrels and closes the breech at the time of each discharge, while the backward motion extracts the empty cartridge cases after firing. The gun can be fired only when the barrels are in motion from left to right; thus as long as the gan is reral operations of loading, firing, and extracting are carried on automatically, uniformly, and continuously. The gun is supplied from feed cases (containing forty cartridges each) which fit into a hopper communicating with the chambers; as soon as one case is emptied another takes its place, and thus continuous firing is kept up at the rate of 1,000 shots per misuce.

Civil Damage Act.

The Civil Damage Act is, in Boston, causing an entire change in the character of eating-houses. A large number of dining piaces will, it is said, change their leases within a week or two on this account, the owners of the buildings declining to sign the bonds of the liquor-selling leasees, and thus make the real estate liable for any damage caused by the sale of liquor in their establishment which may by recovered by course of law. A second and more favorable result is the abolition of beer-pumps and cider-taps in respectable eating-rooms. This law reached the licensed victuallers as no other can. Many of them are impecunious, or have their money so invested that it could not be taken hold of, while the owner of the real estate rented it at a much higher rate than could be obtained for any other purpose without any risk. Now the risk is divided, and if the immediate agent of injury to his customer is not able to pay the damages which the law gives the injured family the estate itself is held responsible. Already it seems as if it were working to advantage, and the step is likely to prove one in the right direction, but a step merely, for it is not prohibition pure and simple, the goal of all such steps ? ----




