consider the enormously increasing amount of grain to be got rid of, the number of settlers going into Manitoba, Minnesota and Dakota, and the supplies which they will need until their own manufacture become built up.

The crops are good but even a farmer can find nothing to grumble at. On one farm, the Daluthy, of which I gave you a detailed account last summer, 115 all standing reapers are being used, cutting between 1,000 and 1,500 acres a day. The whole 15,000 acres in this farm will have been cut by this time. The first lot of this wheat arrived at Duluth on the 7th August, and graded 'Extra No. 1. It is estimated that it will take a train of twenty six cars daily for two weeks to move the crop of this farm. The Daluthy Tribune, in commenting on the matter, says: "Think that, you do not see farmers, ponder to grumble at, then sell your garden patches and come west." We have no idea of the vast extent of the wheat lands of the North West, as it might be called, Minnesota and Dakota. It is estimated that these old extreme limits of a few years ago, the Rocky Mountains and the North Pole, lies a fertile tract—Manitoba, the Red River and Saskatchewan River Districts, and Dakota—that will produce to market 100,000,000 bushels of wheat per year as soon as facilities for shipment are provided. Instead of 'Westward, ho!' the cry will be 'North-Westward, ho!' A few quotations from some of the Northwesters papers will give you an idea of the amazing fertility of the soil: "Fifty bushels of barley to the acre." "Corn eight feet high green on virgin soil." "Golden harvest come again." "The wonders of the Red River Valley this year will be second to the four corners of the world."

"George has ten acres of oats that will yield 700 bushels." "The Stark farm, of 510 acres, will average fifty-five bushels to the acre." "Twenty four acres of the field yielding 1,027 bushels, or nearly forty bushels to the acre." "I have weighed thirty-five to the bushel." "Twenty-five thousand people have settled in the Red River Valley so far this year." "Apples are being successfully cultivated, etc."

Work on the Canada Pacific R.R. is being pushed vigorously forward. About 800 men are at work and more are demanded. Eight miles of track are already laid on the north side of the river. It is estimated that 40 miles will be laid the fall. Work will continue all winter. The contractors intend putting 1,100 men going to work on the 1st of September. Board of Directors met on the 23rd inst. It was an elaborate session. In about a week the contract to build 100 miles of track will be awarded. It is expected that those who ought to know, that contract will be completed in two years, that the line will end about 250 miles of the railroad traffic.

On Wednesday the 13th inst. the first consignment of R.R. iron for the new section C.P.R. arrived at Duluth. There are 11,000 tons of it. It will be placed on the South Pier, and will strike once every three minutes during thick weather.

Two lighthouses are badly needed on Lake Superior, one at the south west entrance of the Victoria Channel, as a lighthouse and fog signal at Passage Island.
