Western States, and the other from

No two shall be citi zens of the same section; the term of office shall be 6 years, and no President having served a full term shall be eligible having served a full term shall be eligible to a second. At first the election of President from the western district shall be elected for a fractional term of two years, and one from the eastern and middle district for six years. After the first election, one President shall be elected from one of the three districts every two years. one of the three districts every two years. Instead of a Vice-President, the Senate shall every four years elect a President of the Senate, who is not a member of that body. The bill further provides that each President shall receive a salary not exceeding \$30,000.
