UNDER THIS ACT, any person who served fourteen days or participated in one battle, in the War of 1812, is entitled to a Pension of \$4 per month from date of approval of Act. Widows of soldiers who have died after similar service, no matter what was the date of marriage to the soldier, are entitled to the same Pension.

No other parties are entitled. All 1812 Pensions dropped from the Rolls because of alleged delinquency are restored by application to a court of record.
