Subsequently, their reluctant replies to Justice O'Rourke's questioning developed the fact that they were out of work, had no resources, and had planned the enterprise with the expectation that they would be paid for the time and trouble and make a good living without any more of the hard work to which they had been accustomed, should it prove successful.

"No," said the Judge, when he had arrived at the bottom part of the case, "supposing you have an honest intent in the matter, do you imagine that the workmen of New York are such fools that, by vague promises of an ultimate fortune, out of which they may get some share of the possible profits, you can induce them to put into your hands money, of which you only promise to return to them 20 per cent? Why should anybody give you their money, when you can give back 10 of them? It is not necessary to go into the question of the illegality of lottery enterprises at present. The prime consideration is that you cannot give among them all at the same time, and such a plan as this, get the necessary resources."

"But," answered one of the philanthropists, "I have determined not to relinquish easily the character I have assumed. I really desire to benefit our fellow-workmen, and if this is not a good way, will you tell us of a better one?"

Yes, promising that you have the confidence of any considerable number of workmen. If you can find 2,000 of them who believe sufficiently in your honesty to intrust you with money, you may do a great deal of good among them, and at the same time make an honest living for yourself. The poor pay the highest prices for all the necessities of life, because their poverty prevents their purchasing in quantity. When I am paying \$4 for a ton of coal, my poor neighbor who buys by the bushel from a corner grocer, or a street vendor, is actually paying at the rate of \$10. When I pay \$2.50 for a barrel of flour, he buying a few pounds at a time, pays almost double as much, even supposing that the grocer is honest in his weights and measures, which is not always the case. In like manner the cost of potatoes and various other things is doubled to him. Suppose, now, that some persons with business ability, energy and unquestionable probity is selected by a number of poor people to hold such small sums of their deposits with him from time to time until each individual depositor has in his hands a sum sufficient to cover the price of quantity of the article he most needs. The aggregation of these deposits will enable the persons retaining them to lay in his stock by great quantities, and consequently, on the most favourable wholesale terms. Take the item of coal, for instance, by way of illustration. How little time it will take for a poor man to save up especially when he puts his money beyond the reach of his own expending—the \$2 necessary to buy a half ton of coal. To put out this much in one lump from his scanty wages for a single week might seem to him impossible, but distributed over the small payments of four or five weeks he does not feel it. But then, by this plan, he would have his half ton of coal for \$2, the market price, and he would have the other half ton for \$4. And the holder of his deposits would reap a fair profit, for he
