Chicago is troubled to find out what to do with all the pork. It seems that the ast sesson's make is still on hand owing to the great curtailment of lumber operations, and the export of live cattle to Europe. The latter trade has to a great extent taken the place of the pork.

Live beef having been brought by rapid transportation to compete with saited ments; a curious question arises. Can the food producing power of American apply all the demands of the increasing population, not only of this continent. population, not only of this continent but also of Europe. When we considered that only a very limited area of this continent is as yet under cultivation, and how poorly that is cultivated, it appears evident that there is practically no limit to the food producing power of America.

The Malthusian destrine that population increases faster than food, although, perhaps, applicable to certain countries, is not likely ever to prove true of America. On the contrary, we have found of late years that the very reverse of Malthoni an theory has been demonstrated by the production of food at a rate nearly one fourth faster than the growth of the population. As a consequence, vast stores of grain and meat are accumulating, while prices show a steady downward it clination. This leads us to hope that extravagant rates of interest and freight will come down to such a figure that money and food can be had at something like their normal value.




