Calendonis, Nov. 12 - The people of the usually quiet village of Caledonia were surprised on Friday morning to learn that the residence of a woman 80 years of age, residing near the H. & N. W. Railway station, had been broken open during the night, the unfortunate woman gagged and her person outraged, and a robbery perpetuated, the scoundrels taking away all the money the poor woman had in the house. Not only had the woman been signed against in the manner indicated, but when discovered in the Battersea and Sunbury—Monday. morning it was found that the gag had been pressed so forcibly into her mouth that the jaws were ususturally distended and the fiesh on either side of the mouth burst open. Six men have been arrested, charged with the crime, and the investigation has since been going on before Mr. John Scott, J. P. The names of some of the parties accused are those of two married men-one of them only three months-and four unmarried men. the facts are as stated by our informant it is to be hoped no pains will be spared to secure the conviction and panishment of the guilty parties; but it is scarcely to be believed that any one could be guilty of the crime charged before Mr. Scotthousebreaking and rape on a woman said to be over 80 years of age.


