

## A Cincinnati Sunday.

In New York they have Sunday evening concerts, "sacred concerts" they call them in the various theatres and gardens, and these are patronized largely by Americans. These sacred concerts are queer affairs. They open with some selection from Rossini such as the Stabat Mater, and then follows "sacred arias" from Girodi, Girola, the Grand Duchess, or some other equally religious composition. In Chicago and St. Louis the Germans have their theatres open on Sunday nights, and they have sacred concerts in beer saloons in full blast. In New Orleans Sunday night is the great theatre night and all the people—the world's people—go to them. But it seems that even in our neighboring state of Ohio the "celebration" of Sunday is rapidly becoming popular. According to the Cincinnati Gazette there are fourteen places of amusement open in that city on Sunday nights. Three of these are opera houses, four are theatres, and the balance are halls, beer houses where concerts are given, and variety show places. There is an attendance of about 10,000 people at those places every Sunday night.
