TOO DECEMBERATING.

In the instances of the most distinguished societies the Marquis then took the President's hand, and afterwards shook hands with each member of the delegation as introduced by the President. It was remarkable to observe with what independence His Excellency discriminated in this matter. In the case of the Church of England he extended his hand to each members, in the case of the Irish Charitable Society he pelitely bewed the whole delegation away, extending his hand to none. In some instances His Excellency extended his hand to the President, only bowing the others away. The North British Society of Halifax came in for a full share of the honors.
