denture. This despand not being acceded to, the young lady was arrested, as an aprentice who had abandoned or deserted from her mistress, when she gave security for hearing of the case before Messrs. Machider and Hall, the sitting Magistrates, Mr. Redier, on the part of the lady, admitted the indenture, and the leaving of the service, and produced the marriage certificate. He cited several authorities from French authors, to prove the nullity and particular stipulation, that the apprentice should not enter upon the happy state of matrimony when a desirable offer was anade, and argued that she was emancipated by her marriage, as much as if she had been indentured for a period beyond majority. The arguments of counsel occupied the Court for some time, and judgement, it is expected, will be pronounced next Tuesday.—Montreal Gazette.
