

MILITIA GENERAL ORDER.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has been pleased to approve of the following Regulations, regarding the Militia, to be issued in future to the Militia, when called out on actual service, and which are promulgated for general information.

1. Pay.—The pay of Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers, Trumpeters, Buglers, Drummers and Privates, of Cavalry and Infantry, is to be the same as that established for the corresponding ranks of Her Majesty's Regular Troops.

2. Rations and Forage.—The Officers and Men of Cavalry and Infantry, when in the field, shall be entitled to receive the usual daily Ration of Provisions, and of Forage for their Horses, as established for Her Majesty's Regular Troops.

3. Allowance in lieu of Rations.—The Officers and Men of Cavalry and Infantry, when in the field, shall be entitled to receive the usual daily Ration of Provisions, and of Forage for their Horses, as established for Her Majesty's Regular Troops.

4. Allowance in lieu of Forage and Stabling.—Officers and Men of Cavalry, and Field Officers and Non-Commissioned Officers of Infantry, will be allowed 9d. per day, in lieu of Forage and Stabling, and of the usual allowance of Forage for their Horses, when they are on duty in the field.

5. Horse Allowance.—Non-commissioned Officers and Men of Cavalry, and of Infantry, when on duty in the field, shall be entitled to receive the usual allowance of Forage for their Horses, as established for Her Majesty's Regular Troops.

6. Lodging Allowance.—The Officers of Cavalry and Infantry, when in the field, shall be entitled to receive the usual allowance of Lodging, as established for Her Majesty's Regular Troops.

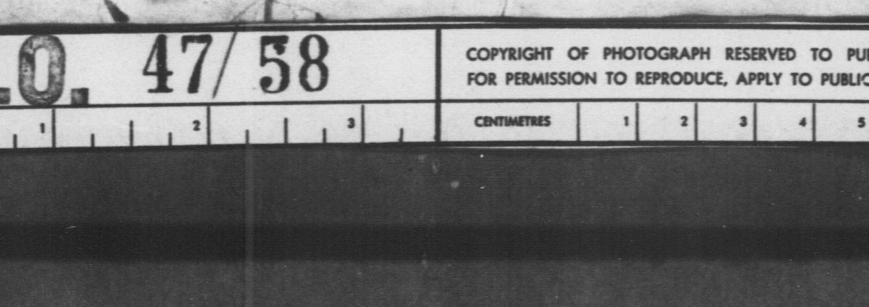
