Some Reform will also be required in the Municipal and Fiscal Laws of Districts and Townships; they must be handled with cautious judgment to meet the circumstances and wants of the Inhabitants; what may be very suitable in one section of Canada, may but ill accord with the wants of the community in another section; the Representatives from the different localities will best be enabled to judge on this point, they of course, whether of French or British origin, will meet the ready attention, and support of Parliament in all measures intended either for general improvement or public convenience.
