RIOTS IN WALES—REBECCA AND HER DAUGHTERS.

The district of North Wales, the inhabitants of which were at one time proverbial for their peaceful habits, has been distinguished by the occurrence, within its locality, of one of the most systematic insurrections which of late years an agricultural district has known. A mob, well organized, and apparently carefully drilled, headed by a stalwart figure dressed in women's clothing, has lately been perpetrating serious outrages upon the peaceful and law-abiding keepers of them. THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD AND THE AMERICAN MINISTER.

It is the custom of the University of Oxford, upon the occasion of the annual commemoration, to confer upon certain distinguished persons selected by themselves the honorary degree of D.C.L. Professor Daniel Webster, of the University of London, and Mr. Everett, the American Minister, were this year chosen to be the persons on whom this honor should be conferred. The moment Mr. Everett's name was mentioned, a storm of disapprobation arose, which increased to such a pitch that the Vice-Chancellor was compelled to dismiss the convention, (after having conferred upon Mr. Everett's name) without hearing the protest of the dissenting members. It is solely and simply a mark of the displeasure of the undergraduates and a certain portion of the graduates against the conferring of a distinguished honor upon a man whose religious opinions which the members of the University of Oxford are sworn to uphold.

IN PARLIAMENT.

June 19, the Irish arms bill was again debated in the House of Commons. Many members condemning the system of coercion adopted by Government, and especially Sir James Graham's speech, in which he declared that conciliation would no longer be attempted. Mr. Wynn's amendment was rejected, 276 to 122.

DUKEDOM REPEAL DEMONSTRATION.

A great repeal demonstration had been made at Dundalk, and the last Dublin Freeman's Journal devotes nearly half its space to a report of the proceedings. Three hundred thousand persons are computed to have been present, with all the excitement of bands and banners, and organized tea-totallers, horse and foot, and it is said that it was a tame affair, and what was, nevertheless, a single powerful "repeal" speech.

THE FRENCH ARMY.

The King of the French is determined to keep up the complement of the army as proposed by the Minister of War, and South and Guizot are endeavoring to frighten the Deputies into compliance by magnifying the disturbances in Spain. The following is the proposed strength of the French Army:—For France, 251,000 infantry, 70,000 cavalry, for Algeria, 60,000 infantry and 13,500 cavalry; total, 425,500.

COURT MARTIAL.

A court martial—a court martial was held at a few days since at the Infantry Barracks, at Windsor, to try private Howkaley, of the Coldstream Guards, upon the charge of having been guilty of using abusive language to his pay-sergeant. He was found guilty and sentenced to receive 100 lashes. The man, who bears an extremely bad character in the regiment, has been previously tried for various offences, before no less than nineteen court martials.
