**PITTSIMMONS RECAPTURED**  
But Cheats the Gallows by Cutting His Throat with a Penknife.  
A Pittsburg dispatch of Feb. 4th says: Frederick Fitzsimmons, formerly of Brockville, Ont., who shot Detective David Gilkinson and almost killed Detective Murray, saved his way out of jail just before he was to have been tried, and for five months has eluded diligent pursuit, having been captured at a cigar stand in New Orleans. Detective Murray left last night to fetch him back. Fitzsimmons mailed a letter to the newspapers the first thing after he broke jail, and has frequently written to counsel and others. A letter to Holmes Anderson, a fellow prisoner, led to his recapture. It is Fitzsimmons made an appointment with Anderson to meet him in New Orleans some days ago. Detectives Finney and Lang of Pittsburg have been in the vicinity of the Crescent city for weeks, shadowing their man. They were aided by the brand of cigarettes he was known to smoke, and which it was found he got at the stand. Three officers pounced on him there soon after midnight and put him in irons before he could shoot.  
A dispatch received the following day from New Orleans says—Frederick C. Fitzsimmons cut his throat with a penknife at 4 o'clock this morning in a cell at the parish prison. He will die. Fitzsimmons left a long letter, in which he says:  
"I have pursued crime with its fatal consequences, my liberty is again jeopardized over my head and do not care a damn in my mind I prefer the latter to imprisonment, disgrace, loss of death, and dragging in the mire still further the name of honorable and respected relatives."  
Fitzsimmons, after writing the letter, jumped into bed, threw a blanket over his head and apparently fell asleep. Half an hour later one of the attendants in the jail heard him groaning, and on going to the bed found Fitzsimmons had slashed his throat three times while under the blanket and was weak from the loss of blood.

**Athens, Feb. 4th, 1892.**  
**Editor Reporter:**  
SIR.—At the nomination meeting in Deaf's last certain charges, more or less grave, were made against members of the Athens Public School Board. Since that time many matters have come to light which give a strong coloring of truth to those charges. In common with many other ratepayers I have waited and, used I say it, I have waited in vain for the publication of the record of the board's doings for the year, which I thought would prove or disprove the many rumors of illegality in circulation.  
Last week's Reporter contained what purported to be the auditor's statement of the financial transactions of the board for the year 1891. The production and publication of which is an insult to the intelligence of the community. Let us consider it a moment. It does not contain the names of those known to the auditors as contributors to the effect that the accounts of the treasurer were examined and found correct; it is stated and beautifully indented with regard to details; it groups things together in a hazy jumble, heterogeneous matter that would be very uninteresting if the question at issue were not so serious; and, to cap all, it is signed by a gentleman who was a trustee during 1891. Is this, I ask, a fair, full and sufficient account of the expenditure of the sum of \$3,824.18 of the people's money? No wonder the council rejected it. The idea of attempting to impose such a thing upon an intelligent people! But the trustee board accepted it—Oh, yes, it was evidently very much to their liking.  
Now the law regarding such a simple matter as this is very plain, and it must be clearly evident to all. It is so plain that there was no necessity for urging, except from sinister motives. Let me briefly state the mode of procedure required by the statutes and departmental regulations. At the close of each year it is the duty of the treasurer to furnish the municipal auditors with a financial statement in detail and abstract form, and this on being certified by the auditors as correct, accepted by the council, and signed by the clerk, should be forwarded to the department before the first of March.
