CLOSE OF THE SESSION.

END OF THE THIRD SESSION OF THE SEVENTH PARLIAMENT.

Very Unostentatious Proceedings—The Royal Assent to the Bills Passed During the Session—Speech from the Throne—The Province Congratulated Upon Various Things.

TORONTO, May 28.—In striking contrast to the pomp and splendor with which the Assembly was opened on April 4th were the proceedings on Monday of today. The actors in the closing scene played to a very thin house. Not more than 50 people were scattered through the galleries and about a score were on the floor. Fifteen minutes saw the whole act through. Shortly before two o'clock detachment from the Royal Canadian Regiment of Infantry, under command of Lieut. Laurie, marched up to the buildings by way of College street, and were drawn up in front of the great stone pile as a guard of honor. A few minutes after their Honour Lieut. Governor Kirkpatrick, accompanied by Commander Law, R.N., Lieut. Col. Hamilton of the Q.O.R., Capt. Greville-Harston, R.G., and Lieut. Arthur Kirkpatrick, O.C. drove up to the front of the guard at the present arms. The band of the R.C.R. played the National Anthem as this Honour entered the chamber. The members of the Legislature—Sir Oliver Mowat, Messrs. Hardy, Gibson (Hon. Sec.), and the Hon. Mr. Justice, Monk, Hicott, Sharpe, Ballantyne, Charlton, Balfour, Tait, Gilmore, Eyerson, and Smith (Frontenac), Mr. Justice Ocker, Mr. Justice MacLennan, and Vice-Chief Justice Rooney.

The proceedings were opened in a plain business-like way absolutely without ostentation or flourish.

Mr. Syden, assistant clerk without the titles of the bills passed during the session, and the royal assent was formally given to the bills.

His Honour then said:—Mr. Speaker and Gentlemen of the Legislature.

In relieving you from further attendance upon your legislative duties, I am glad to be able to congratulate you upon the advantages which have already been experienced from the completion of the new Parliament buildings. While they have greatly continued to your comfort and convenience in the discharge of your legislative duties, they have also proved themselves to be perfectly adapted to the needs of the public service. It is very satisfactory to know that buildings so substantial and commodious have been erected at comparatively so low a cost.

I desire to express my appreciation of the diligence and zeal with which you have discharged your duties during the session. Although called together at a season of the year when the demands of private business are most urgent, you have not only discharged your duties with consideration and care, but you have also shown a most commendable interest in the progress of the session.

I recognize with pleasure your prudence and forethought in providing for the establishment of a large national park, about 19,000 square miles in area, in the northern part of the province, and in thereby securing for all time a forest reservation of untold value to the country, and a pleasure to the people.

I am glad to see that the connection between the park and its future occupants, while among other advantages, its ample area of lake and forest will furnish excellent facilities for the enjoyment of the people.

I heartily concur in the provisions of your Act granting liberal aid to certain sections of the province, to be taken on the condition that the money to be expended shall be applied to the improvement of the roads, and to the construction of bridges, and to the improvement of the harbors, and to the improvement of the navigation, and to the improvement of the fisheries, and to the improvement of
